

Radiologic Technology Program Effectiveness Data

Graduates will pass the ARRT examination. The five-year average first-time pass rate on the ARRT examination will be greater than or equal to **85%**.

2014	100%	18 of 19 graduates responded, 18 of 18 were employed within 12 mos.
2013	81%	16 of 20 graduates responded, 13 of 16 were employed within 12 mos.
5-year average	94%	81 of 86 were employed within 12 mos.
