

HESI LPN Entrance Exam Information

Thank you for taking the HESI exam at the Maine College of Health Professions. The results will be used to help us determine admission into the program.

Admission into the LPN program requires a minimum score of 70 in all of the sections: Reading Comprehension, Grammar, Vocabulary, and Basic Math. Candidates that score below 70 in the required sections will not be considered for admission.

Please refer to the chart below to determine the number of points awarded. Applicants may re-take the HESI one time during the admissions cycle. Applicants may re-take the entire exam or portions of the exam. We will use the highest score for each section.

Section	Score 70-79	Score 80-89	Score 90-99	100
Reading Comprehension	2 points	3 points	4 points	5 points
Grammar	2 points	3 points	4 points	5 points
Vocabulary	2 points	3 points	4 points	5 points
Basic Math	2 points	3 points	4 points	5 points
