Admission Checklist

- Complete the online application - <http://mchp.edu/apply-now>
- Pay the \$50 application fee – non-refundable
- Send official high school transcripts or GED/HiSET directly to MCHP from your high schools (Home school students should contact the admissions office.)
 - High School Graduate or equivalent
 - Biology with a grade of “C” or higher: high school, college, or adult education*
 - Chemistry with a grade of “C” or higher: high school, college, or adult education*
 - Algebra with a grade of “C” or higher: high school, college, or adult education*
 - 2nd Math course with a grade of “C” or higher: high school, college, or adult education*
- Send official college transcripts directly to MCHP from your colleges
- Send SAT or ACT results or 12 college credits with a grade of “C” or higher
- Schedule Entrance Exam - <https://www.mchp.edu/entrance-exams/>
 - HESI A2 Nurses Entrance Exam Must score 80% in the following categories: Grammar, Vocabulary, Reading, Anatomy & Physiology, and Math (Alternative Entrance Exams, such as the TEAS, may not replace the HESI Examination).

*A&P I, lecture and lab, with a grade of “C” or higher will satisfy the Biology or Chemistry requirement.
A&P II, lecture and lab, with a grade of “C” or higher will satisfy the Biology or Chemistry requirement.

All application materials must be received by the required deadline.

Note: Upon acceptance into the program, students must provide the following documentation:

- Immunizations and/or titers (***No medical records should be submitted upon application***)
- CPR Certification
- Criminal Background Check
