Admission Checklist

- Complete the online application - <http://mchp.edu/apply-now>
- Pay the \$50 application fee – non-refundable
- Official, state approved, high school (or GED/HiSET) transcript sent directly to the College. (High school transcripts are not required if applicant has graduated from an associate's or bachelor's degree program from a regionally accredited institution at the time the application is submitted.)
- Transcripts from associate degree nursing programs must be from an ACEN accredited college/university. Associate degree programs (RN) which are not accredited by ACEN will not meet the Requirement.
- Official college/university transcript(s) sent directly to MCHP
 - A&P I with lab with a grade of “C” or higher
 - A&P II with lab with a grade of “C” or higher
 - Microbiology w/lab with a grade of “C” or higher
 - College Writing with a grade of “C” or higher
 - Introduction to Psychology with a grade of “C” or higher
 - Developmental Psychology with a grade of “C” or higher
 - Arts/Humanities Elective with a grade of “C” or higher
 - Social Science Elective with a grade of “C” or higher
- Provide verification of official, unrestricted, and active License as a Registered Nurse
 - Note: Students currently completing an A.D.N. program are eligible to apply for the program during their final semester of their A.D.N. program. They may be conditionally accepted into the RN-BSN program pending successful completion of the A.D.N. program and successful RN licensure.

All application materials must be received by the required deadline.

Note: Upon acceptance into the program, students must provide the following documentation:

- Immunizations and/or titers (***No medical records should be submitted upon application***)
- CPR Certification
- Criminal Background Check
